



CALL FOR SPEAKERS

Interested speakers are invited to submit topics and summary abstracts for the North Alabama Chapter of the Information Systems Security Association (ISSA) and Cyber Huntsville (CH) 4th Annual North Alabama Cyber Security Summit on June 7, 2012. This one day event attracts 450+ attendees and 36 vendors providing opportunities for business and intellectual engagement among attendees on technical and management topics related to Information Assurance and Cyber Security. There is no registration fee for speakers of accepted topics.

The theme for this year’s Summit is **“Next Generation Cyber: Developing Capabilities and Minimizing Vulnerabilities”**. Suggested topics for submission of papers are listed below (but not limited to):

Papers will be selected for presentation based on topic originality, technical or management content, relevance to the Conference theme, and interest to the Conference audience. Electronic submission is required in pdf or standard Microsoft Office applications. Vendor submission must be vendor neutral and approach the topic area from a technical or management approach rather than vendor specific product or solution.
